

These youthful performers represent five different villages from the Interior including: Tanana, Venetie, Arctic Village, Allakaket, and Fort Yukon.

Native communities throughout North America are initiating cultural heritage programs to document and maintain traditional knowledge, and build upon it for the future. Involving youth is considered essential in making this process successful. At the Fairbanks Native Association, Bernice Joseph coordinates a growing cultural heritage program involving youth and

Through her work with Jane Lind, a noted Aleut actor and director, Bernice has become an advocate for youth involvement in theatre and performance. She notes, "Jane Lind has opened my eyes to the positive effects of performing for our youth."
